**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX RATE INCREASE  
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – On July 18, 2006, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners increased the tourist development tax rate from five percent (5%) to six percent (6%). The August 2006 returns, which are due September 1, 2006 and must be postmarked no later than September 20, 2006, will be the last returns with the 5% rate. Beginning with the September returns, which are due in October, all dealers are required to use the new rate.

Living quarters and accommodations in a hotel, motel, rooming house, trailer camp, condominium, apartment, multiple-unit structure, mobile home, trailer, single-family home, or any other sleeping accommodations that are rented for six months or less are subject to the tourist development tax.
